

## PERENNIALS AT RHODES' 2011

**acanthus mollis** a big and bold plant. It has some of the finest foliage in the plant kingdom. The leaves have been inspiration for many important decorative Western art and architectural designs. In hot summer areas, *A. mollis* dies back to the ground during summer only to return when the weather cools off. It could take a couple of years to get it to flower, but it is well worth the wait

**achillea** "Pomegranate" rich magenta-red flowers strong stems, exceptional disease resistance

**agastache** "Ava" tall spikes of rose-pink tubular flowers for 3 months in summer on tall strong stems

**agastache a.** "Apricot Sprite" dwarf, compact cultivar has fragrant, grey-green foliage topped with spikes of vibrant peachy-apricot flowers

**alcea r.** hollyhock "Blacknight" deep black-purple flowers. part of a brand new line of straight color, single flowered hollyhocks that are truly perennial

**alcea r.** hollyhock "Mars Magic" bright red flowers. . part of a brand new line of straight color, single flowered hollyhocks that are truly perennial

**alcea r.** hollyhock "Polar Star" pure white flowers w/yellow eye. part of a brand new line of straight color, single flowered

hollyhocks that are truly perennial

**alcea r.** hollyhock "Sunshine" bright yellow flowers. part of a brand new line of straight color, single flowered hollyhocks that are truly perennial

**allium** "Globemaster" Large, dense flowers, 10" across, with an abundance of violet purple florets that bloom for weeks. Flowers May to July.  
**allium caeruleum** "Azureum" Carefree and rewarding! Unusual flax-blue flower heads, approximately 1 1/2" in diameter. Summer blooming, 24" tall.

**allium schubertii** Carefree and rewarding! Large blooms with small reddish-purple flowers in June-July on 30" stems.

**alstromeria** "Tangerine Tango" vibrant array of tangerine colored flowers blanket plant from May til first frost, z-6 could use some extra protection in winter in z-5

**anemone** "Pink Saucer" uniform growth habit, begins blooming early summer and continues into fall with large pink flowers

**aruncus aethusifolia** dwarf goatsbeard, fine glossy foliage, creamy white feathery spikes of flowers

**asclepias tuberosa**, butterfly milkweed longlasting tangerine orange flowers

**aster** "Blue Autumn" vivid blue, daisy-like flowers are produced freely on strong, upright, disease resistant plants  
**astilbe** "Burgundy Red" dark red scapes carry raspberry-red buds that open to a rich burgundy red, glossy deep green foliage

**astilbe** "Younique Carmine" compact foliage and brilliant fuschia-red plumes

**belamcanda** "Hello Yellow" blackberry lily, iris-like foliage, bright yellow star shaped flowers

**brunnera** "Jack Frost" silver overlay and green veining on large heart shaped leaves, sprays of tiny sky-blue forget-me-not flowers in early spring

**callirhoe i.** can be used as groundcover or in mixed beds, deeply dissected dark green foliage adorned with electric pink-purple cupped flowers from July into Sept.

**camassia** "Blue Melody" Tall regal spikes of violet blue flowers rise above handsome strap-like variegated foliage. Likes damp soil.

**campanula** "Dwarf Pink" compact and floriferous with vivid star shaped pink flowers

**campanula** "Freya" extremely floriferous selection producing dense clusters of lilac-purple, star shape flowers

**cimicifuga** "Brunette" bugbane, dark bronze-black

foliage topped with spikes of pale, soft pink very fragrant bottlebrush flowers, a must have!

**cimicifuga** "Chocoholic" dark purple-black, lacy foliage is striking enough, **but wait**, there's more, in late summer spikes of mauve-to-white flowers appear along with a sweet strong fragrance

**coreopsis** "Crème Brulee" similar to "Moonbeam" but with larger flowers and improved mildew resistance

**coreopsis** "Heavens Gate" two toned flowers of pink and rosy-crimson about 1" wide, shear back late spring for fuller plant with more buds, blooms all summer

**coreopsis** "Sunbeam" a darker golden version of "Moonbeam"

**crocosmia** "Bright Eyes" brilliant orange flowers over iris-like foliage

**crocosmia** "Lucifer" Brilliant flame red flowers above broad swordlike foliage

**crocosmia** "Walberton Yellow" large golden-yellow blossoms on upright stems, sword-like foliage

**delosperma dyeri** large starburstflowers in shades of coral and orange from spring til fall, shiny succulent foliage

**delosperma n.** "Basutoland" yellow flowering ice plant , shiny green succulent foliage, blooms may + june

**delphinium** "Aurora Blue" new hybrid with great vigor, sturdy stems and tall spires of bright blue double flowers with a white bee, VERY SHOWY

**delphinium** "Butterfly Blue" short and compact with fernlike foliage and deep blue flowers

**delphinium** "Summer Morning" dwarf form, lacy mounds of foliage with a multitude of light pink flowers, early bloomer

**delphinium** "Summer Nights" midnight blue flowers on compact well branched plant

**delphinium e.** "Black Eyed Angels" frilly pure white flowers with a black bee, a tall handsome plant even when not in bloom

**delphinium e.** "Moonlight Blues" a short selection with stout flower spikes of sky blue flowers, trim main spike after bloom to encourage secondary flowering

**delphinium exaltatum** wild delphinium, tall stems carrying blue flowers, nice for woodland garden

**dianthus** "Heart Attack" heart-stopping-red flowers are produced on long stems over a long season

**dianthus** "Little Maiden" very compact form, white fringed flowers late in summer

**dicentra** "Bacchanal" fernleaf bleeding heart with dark red flowers scented of cinnamon, repeat blooms through the summer

**dicentra** "Burning Hearts" fern-leaf bleeding heart, rose-red heart shaped flowers are produced all season atop ferny blue-green foliage fantastic!

**dicentra** "Spectabilis Alba" *old fashioned bleeding heart*, bushy clumps of green leaves on fleshy stems, strings of white heart

shaped flowers dangle below

**dicentra** "Spectabilis" *old fashioned bleeding heart*, bushy clumps of green leaves on fleshy stems, strings of pink heart

shaped flowers dangle below

**dicentra** "Valentine" a true red old fashioned bleeding heart

**dicentra spectabilis** "Goldheart" *old fashioned bleeding heart*, bushy clumps of

bright gold leaves on fleshy stems, strings of pink heart shaped flowers dangle below

**digitalis** "Dalmation Purple" perennial foxglove with tall, strong stems and deep lavender-purple flowers

**echinacea** "Firebird" large flaming red-orange coneflowers with reflexed petals on well branched plant for many weeks in summer

**echinacea** "Green Jewel" unique fragrant, green coneflowers with darker green cone on relatively short plant

**echinacea** "Hot Papaya" sizzling red-orange pompom fragrant flowers, lasts nearly 2 weeks as a cut flower

**echinacea** "Irrisistible"  
rainbow sherbet double flowers,  
each bloom is one of a kind.

**echinacea** "Magnus Superior"  
an improved strain of "Magnus"  
purple coneflower

**echinacea** "Marmalade"  
fragrant, tangerine-to-  
golden/orange pompom flowers  
on well branched plant

**echinacea** "Now Cheesier"  
huge, non-fading, golden yellow  
blooms on well branched upright  
plant

**echinacea** "Pow Wow Wild  
Berry" new series, bred to be  
compact and well branched  
resulting in more 3"-4" rose  
purple flowers, blooms  
continuously without deadheading

**echinacea** "Ruby Star" large  
flowered coneflower of deep  
pink, with petals held  
horizontally

**echinacea** "Tangerine Dream"  
elegant, clear-orange 4" blooms,  
holds color better than any  
other and has sweet honey scent

**echinacea** "Tomato Soup"  
warm tomato-red flowers up to  
5" across, cover this well  
branched plant from mid-summer  
till frost

**echium** "Red Feathers" low  
growing mounds of dark leathery  
green foliage, feathery spikes of  
russet red rise in the spring, will  
re-bloom if deadheaded

**fuschia** m "Cape Horn" shrub-  
like upright mounding habit,

bright magenta and purple  
flowers dangle from branch tips

**gaillardia** "Arizona Red  
Shades" masses of large,  
crimson-red flowers produced  
over a long period in summer on  
compact plant

**gaillardia** "Mesa Yellow"  
vigorous well branched plant  
producing abundant yellow  
flowers all summer

**gentiana** "Blue Cross" compact  
plant with clusters of intense  
blue-violet flowers over a long  
season

**geranium** "Dark Reiter" finely  
cut deep purple foliage covered  
in lilac-blue blossoms all summer

**geranium** "Tiny Monster",  
bright deep pink blooms over  
mounds of green foliage, long  
blooming

**heuchera** "Berry Smoothie"  
unique foliage color changes  
seasonally from pinks to purplish  
rose

**heuchera** "Caramel" *coral*  
*bells*, vigorous selection has  
large glowing yellow-orange  
foliage

**heuchera** "Citronelle" robust  
citron yellow foliage with  
silvered undersides

**heuchera** "Electra" electric-  
yellow with bright red veining in  
the spring, softening later in the  
summer

**heuchera** "Marmalade" *coral*  
*bells* shiny undulating leaves of  
umber to deep sienna

**heuchera** "Midnight Rose"  
a cool sport of *Obsidian*, glossy  
near-black foliage, marbled with  
pink splashes

**heuchera** "Obsidian" *coral bells*  
, black shiny foliage

**heuchera** "Plum Royale" the  
first heuchera to maintain  
consistently plum-purple foliage  
all summer, needs sunshine to  
develop the purple pigment

**heucherella** "Sweet Tea"  
unique coloration, apricot-orange  
with burgundy center splotch in  
spring, darkens to coppery  
orange, russet and cinnamon  
tones in summer

**hibiscus** "Cranberry Crush"  
naturally compact plant with  
near-black buds that open to  
cranberry-red 8" flowers

**hibiscus** "Fireball" *rose mallow*,  
finely cut leaves flushed with  
purple, giant flaming red flowers  
10-12" across

**hibiscus** "Jazberry Jam"  
heavily ruffled 9" flowers of  
magenta on robust upright plant

**hibiscus** "Party Favor" super  
long bloomer with 8-10" glossy  
pink flowers from mid-summer to  
frost

**hibiscus** "Sultry Kiss" super  
long bloom time from mid-  
summer til frost, has huge  
magenta-red flowers

**hibiscus** "Summer Storm"  
deep wine-purple foliage,  
compact habit[3-4'], 8" pink  
flowers

**iris g.** "Avalon Sunset" bright eye-catching orange with tangerine beards

**iris g.** "Before The Storm" deep purple-neary-jet-black flowers

**iris g.** "Breakers" medium blue with billowing ruffles, prolific bloomer

**iris g.** "Saturday Night Live" mammoth, ruby-red velvety flowers , sturdy stems

**iris g.** "Immortality" pure white with light lemon beards , nicely ruffled and fragrant

**iris g.** "Picasso Moon" brilliant yellow large blooms and tall thick stems

**kalimeris** "Blue Star" everblooming compact plant with pale blue daisy-like flowers over deep green shiny foliage

**lamium** "Orchid Frost" silver and green leaves with large orchid colored flowers

**lamium** "Purple Dragon" silvery foliage larger spikes of purple snapdragon-like flowers

**lavandula** "Blue River" a more compact selection that produces highly fragrant intensely purple flowers over a long season

**lavandula** "Green Summer" compact plant but profuse bloomer, produces a canopy of 2" dark purple cones with large violet "butterfly" flowers, not terribly hardy, but a great patio container plant

**lavandula** "Grosso" lavender, fragrant, plump flower spikes of violet-blue

**lavandula** "Ellagance Purple" bushy silver-green foliage, produces spikes of intense, purple-blue flowers

**leptinella squalida** "Platts Black" low growing plant with feathery bronzy-black foliage, interesting groundcover

**leucanthemum** "Banana Cream" a nice compact, well branched Shasta daisy with lemon yellow flowers

**ligularia japonica** huge dramatic dark green leaves, deeply dissected, create a 4ft.mound, topped by 6ft stems holding clusters of yellow-orange daisies in late summer

**lilium Asiatic** "Double Elodie" dbl pink

**lilium Asiatic** "Double Fata Morgana" dbl yellow

**lilium Asiatic** "Mount Duckling" pink

**lilium Asiatic** "New Wave" white

**lilium Asiatic** "Orange Matrix"

**lilium Asiatic** "Petite Brigitte" yellow

**lilium oriental** "Angelique" pink/white

**lilium oriental** "Casa Blanca" white

**lilium oriental** "Cobra" dark red

**lilium oriental** "Farolito" lt pink

**lilium oriental** "Stargazer" pink/red

**lilium ot** "Robina" red

**lilium spec** "Black Beauty" deep pink

**lilium tiger** orange

**lilium tiger** yellow

**lilium trumpet** Golden Splendour" yellow

**lobelia siphilitica** blue spikes in August and Sept

**lupinus** "Tutti Fruitti Hybrids" tall thick flower spikes in broad range of colors

**monarda** "Grand Mum" medium clumps of dark green fragrant foliage topped with light pink-mauve full flowers that resemble mums

**monarda** "Jacob Cline" large, bright red florets top stocky square strong stems, reported to be quite mildew resistant

**monarda** "Pink Lace" mid-sized plant with light pink flowers with purple centers

**monarda** "Purple Rooster" true, royal purple flowers top plant with excellent mildew resistance

**musa basjoo** *hardy banana, yes, hardy banana!!!* From Japan ,this 6'+ tropical looking plant will survive[-20]f

**oenothera** "Ozark Sundrops" canary yellow flowers up to 3" across

**oxalis** "Rosea" low mounds of vivid green, clover-like leaves dotted with small pink flowers,

blooms all summer, best in moist partial shade to shade

**papaver** "Summer Breeze Orange"& "Summer Breeze Yellow" similar to Iceland poppies in appearance, these sterile hybrids produce flowers significantly longer

**penstemon** "Dark Towers" deep wine purple foliage holds color all summer, produces masses of lavender pink flowers on strong stems

**penstemon** "Pinacolada Violet" early bloomtime and very free flowering compact plant with violet/purple flowers

**peony ten.** "Rubra Flora Plena" crimson red single flowers, over fine ferny leaves

**perovskia** "Little Spire" *Russian sage*, short upright habit, narrow gray-green leaves, lavender blue flowers

**phlox** "Flame Pink" a new series of compact garden phlox with bushy habit and large fragrant flowers, excellent mildew resistance

**phlox** "Flame Purple" a new series of compact garden phlox with bushy habit and large fragrant flowers, excellent mildew resistance

**physostegia** "Crystal Peak" compact and early flowering with spires of pure white flowers all summer

**primula** "Salvana" deep violet-blue trumpet flowers held pincushion style atop silver

stems, each flower is dusted with silver on top

**prunella** "Freelander Blue" carpets of dark green foliage producing masses of violet-blue flowers from late spring into fall, excellent groundcover

**pulmonaria** "Little Star" compact, but floriferous with pink buds that mature to cobalt blue

**pulmonaria** "Raspberry Splash" narrow silver splashed foliage with clusters of dusky raspberry-coral flowers

**rheum** "Chipman's Canada Red" rhubarb

**rudbeckia** "City Garden" compact habit and long bloomtime make this black eyed susan a great choice for smaller gardens

**salvia** "Madeline" large showy bicolor blooms of white and brilliant violet-blue

**salvia** "Sensation rose" short spikes of bright rose-pink flowers on dwarf sized plant

**salvia g.** "Ultra Violet" an abundance of intense violet flowers over finely cut foliage from mid summer into fall

**sedum** "Postman's Pride" deep purple foliage with semi-upright habit, drought tolerant

**tanacetum** "Robinsons Red" *painted Daisy*, scarlet red daisy-like flowers over ferny green foliage

**teucrium** "Purple Tails" reddish purple flower spikes resemble a veronica in bloom

**thermopsis** "Sophia" a great profusion of canary-yellow flower spikes in early spring, looks like a hardy lupine.

**tricyrtis** "Blue Wonder" compact dark green foliage with light blue flowers spotted deep violet-blue

**tricyrtis** "Miyazaki Hybrids" long arching hairy stems, lance-like leaves and small white orchid-like flowers spotted with purple

**tricyrtis** "Sinonome" draught tolerant toad lily, upright facing white flowers with ruby speckling, strong stems, is grown as a cut flower in Japan

**veronia** "Iron Butterfly" a compact version of the native ironweed, fine foliage and is covered with true purple flowers in late summer, a butterfly magnet

**veronica** "Blue Bomb" plumes of flowers similar to that of astilbes, each plume holds hundreds of bright blue flowers

**veronica** "Fairytale" 7" long spikes of two-tone flowers of silvery pink and dark rose

**veronica** "Hocus Pocus" uniform habit, clean foliage and branched flowers of vivid violet purple, perfect for a special spot

**veronica** "Sweet Lullaby" sweet and petite, pure baby pink
