

VINES AT RHODES' 2011

- ampelopsis** "Elegans" *variegated porcelain vine*, highly variegated leaves, new growth is pink, fall berries in Easter pastels
- campsis** "Flamenco" *trumpetvine* vigorous vine, brilliant orange-red flowers summer into fall
- campsis** "Judy" very floriferous trumpet vine sporting deep golden flowers with orange throats
- campsis** "Mme. Galen" *trumpetvine* vigorous vine, showy clusters of deep apricot flowers in summer and fall
- campsis** r. "Flava" *trumpetvine* bright cheery yellow flowers in summer
- celastrus** s. "Autumn Revolution" *bittersweet* produces berries on every plant without a mate, produces astonishing quantity of fruit that is double the size of the species

- hydrangea anom petiolaris** climbing hydrangea, will cling to walls or trees, produces beautiful white lacecap type flowers midsummer
- lathyrus** l. *perennial sweet pea* delicate flowers of rose, pink or white appear prolifically all summer, 4-6'
- lonicera** "Goldflame" *honeysuckle*, woody vine prized for its fragrant rosy-red flowers from June til frost, shade tolerant
- lonicera** "Graham Thomas" Fabulously fragrant, large, tubular, white flowers, ageing to yellow, from July to September and oval, mid-green leaves
- lonicera** "Honeybelle" easy to grow vine for experts or beginners, the first flush of blossoms is like a waterfall of gold, and will repeat consistently well into fall
- lonicera** "John Clayton" fragrant, pale yellow flowers beginning in June and repeating well into fall
- lonicera** "Major Wheeler" extra-long flowering coral honeysuckle, typically blooms heavily in spring and continues through summer
- lonicera** "Texas Scarlet" tubular fragrant flowers of scarlet-yellow-orange, not as aggressive as japonica types
- passiflora** "Incarната" *hardy passion flower vine*, zone 5, vigorous clinging vine, fast growing to 15'+, exotic fragrant flowers of white/lavender/purple appear July to frost
- schizophragma** "Roseum" *false hydrangea vine*, beautiful clear pink lacecap-type flowers June-July, great on north facing wall or trained up a tall tree
- vitis purpurea** an ornamental vine grown for its extraordinary purple-green foliage and it's stunning fall color
- wisteria** "Blue Moon" large, showy lilac-blue flowers held in foot-long racemes like clusters of grapes, sweet intense fragrance, **blooms 3 times a season**
